Te Kahu, Gimblett Gravels, Craggy Range Hawke's Bay, New Zealand			63
This is a blend of Bordeaux grape varieties, but it comes from the famous Gimblett Gravels soil of Hawkes Bay in New Zealand. Craggy are a serious outfit and this wine overdelivers on so many levels. Powerful, yet smooth, this wine needs to be enjoyed slowly.
